Antler Wave—\$95—8 Hours

Intermediate/ Advanced

Using a pre-drilled antler as the foundation with main spokes already glued into antler, student will learn how to weave with two strands of round reed (treated as one). Nubby yarn will be used and body of basket will be woven in a 3 rod wale pattern or triple twine for this antler table-top basket sculpture. Rim has a double woven border. Instructor will demonstrate proper drilling and teach "tricks of the trade".



Alaskan Cedar Mail Basket -\$125—8 Hours

Intermediate Advanced

Learn the joy of weaving with hand harvested western red and Alaskan yellow cedar bark, gathered by the instructor from Thorne Bay Alaska! With this basket you will learn traditional Haida techniques for preparation and weaving with cedar.

This basket has a modern twist that allows the unique shape with the high back to be formed. Leather straps weave through to hang for mail.

A small awl, scissors, towel and spay bottle will be needed.

This great basket starts with multi-colored stakes and is woven in a 2/2 twill in black. This striking black wrapped handle is added and the basket is rimmed and lashed in black. A great basket to add some excitement to your collection!
